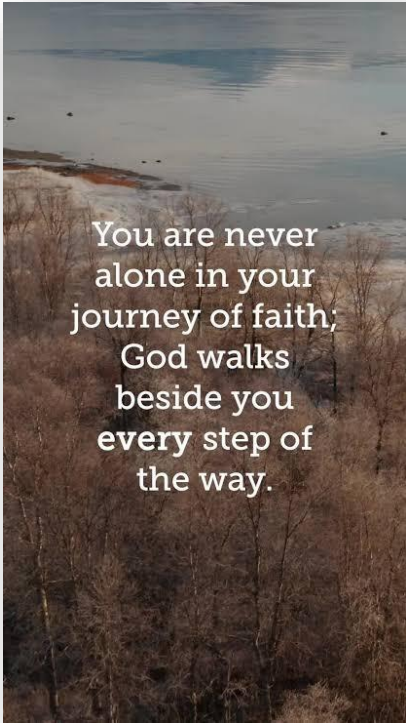
New Opportunity to Serve – Visitation Ministry
